The July Board meeting was held virtually via Microsoft Teams and chaired by Heather Watson. The meeting began with an Acknowledgement of Traditional Owners and a values share that highlighted the Festival of Care at Jimbulang Place and recognised leadership contributions across CHQ.

The Board discussed a wide range of strategic and operational matters, including:

- Reflecting with the Executive on the key achievements and challenges of the past financial year and ideas for transformational priorities to elevate CHQ's performance.
- Receiving an update on the Stage 2 Protected Industrial Action by the Queensland Nurses and Midwives' Union.
- The Board's continued support for the Queensland Children's Gender Service and engagement with the Department of Health during the ongoing review

The Board approved the 2025–26 CHQ Budget Report and the annual compliance attestation for the National Safety and Quality Health Service Standards.
