Strokes can happen in kids

They're rare but they do occur.

Because they're rare diagnosis can be delayed.

Consider activating CODE STROKE in children with sudden:

- Focal weakness
- Visual disturbances
- Speech and language disturbances
- Limb incoordination or ataxia

- Altered mental status
- Sudden headache
- Signs of raised ICP
- Seizures with additional neurological symptoms
