SAAnaesthesia

Children's Health Queensland will introduce a new integrated electronic medical record (ieMR) module – SAAnaesthesia – as part of its ieMR Advanced Project rollout in April 2018.

SAAnaesthesia will replace current paper-based anaesthetic records, electronically capture vital signs and allow electronic documentation of the anaesthetic delivered to patients. This information will automatically upload into the ieMR.

SAAnaesthesia will incorporate the management of workflow, electronic medication ordering and administration, case documentation and anaesthetic device integration.

All medications administered within SAAnaesthesia will be visible on the patient's medication record with the final anaesthetic record available for review in PowerChart once the case has been finalised.

Benefits for staff

- Streamlined and integrated flow of anaesthetic information through the ieMR.
- Visibility of real-time vitals, medications, fluids and blood products administered in theatre through device integration for anaesthetic machines.
- Plans will be automatically captured.

Benefits for patients

Built-in decision support and cognitive aids to assist with providing better patient care.

Who is affected?

SAAnaesthesia will be used by anaesthetists and anaesthetic assistants to document anaesthetic service provision.

Training

An extensive training program will be implemented to ensure staff receive information and support before, during and following implementation of the new module. Training will be compulsory for anaesthetists.
