Fact sheet Reporting

Children's Health Queensland (CHQ) will introduce a new Children's Health Intelligence Reporting Portal (CHIRPs) as part of its ieMR Advanced project rollout in April 2018.

The easy-to-use portal will standardise legislative, management and operational reporting across the organisation and allow for more consistent and tailored reporting. CHIRPs will provide one-click access to all CHQ reports and enable staff to easily analyse and move between clinical records.

Benefits for staff

- Direct access to up-to-date data.
- One-stop-shop for all reporting across the organisation.
- Tailored dashboards to meet business needs.
- Accessible on mobile devices.

What will change?

From 11 April, staff will have the opportunity to use CHIRPs to:

- access existing reports
- request new reports
- request changes to current reports.

Existing report links will not change but staff are encouraged to transition to CHIRPs as it provides a range of new and improved reporting capabilities.

Who is affected?

This change will affect all staff who are involved in reporting including clinicians, management, executive and divisional reporting analysts.

How will staff be supported?

A range of resources and support will be available for staff from early April 2018. These will include how-to guides, a CHIRPs website and at-the-elbow training by the ieMR team, as needed.
