Read on...

The Viewer gives you easy access to information such as patient details, encounters, procedures and ED information, medication summaries, pathology and radiology reports, adverse reactions and discharge summary information.

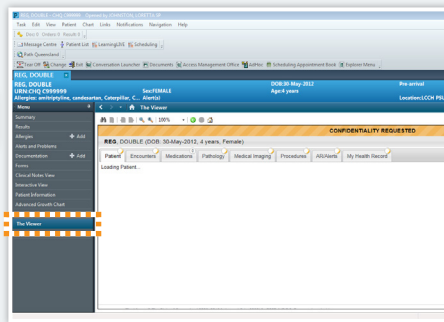
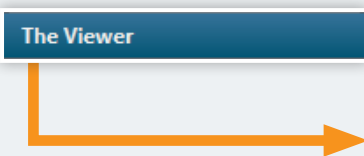
You can access The Viewer from within the ieMR to save time logging into multiple systems.

The Viewer in the ieMR contains the following key information

- Patient demographics (including next of kin), admission and discharge history
- Validated pathology results and tests ordered (AUSLAB)
- Mental Health data (Consumer Integrated Mental Health Application (CIMHA))
- Problems and primary diagnosis from emergency departments and hospital admissions
- Discharge summaries
- Medication profiles (eLMS) and adverse reactions
- Summary of operation notes (ORMIS and ieMR - digital sites only)
- Medical imaging reports
- Alerts (CIMHA, ieMR and images)
- Clinical reports (IMPAX CV - CATH and ECHO)
