Technology is a big part of our lives – and that includes your child's health care.

Children's Health Queensland is introducing a new system to help us electronically manage medical records and the scheduling of appointments. This will mean using computers instead of paper files.

Ultimately, this will make sure the healthcare teams supporting your child all have access to the same real-time medical information – no matter where you go for care.



Real-time benefits

The shift to one electronic medical record will:

- Make sure all members of your healthcare team are using the latest, most complete information in caring for your child
- Make it easier to coordinate booking times (if you are accessing multiple services)
- Create a central source of information about your child's health that can help any healthcare team who treats them as they grow up.

What does this mean for patients?

Your healthcare team will use computers instead of paper files to document and access real-time patient medical information. A healthcare team will enter information about your child directly into their personal medical record during the consultation.

Your appointments and referrals will also be managed as part of a single electronic record, which will help coordinate booking times (if you are accessing multiple services).
