There are five system wide COVID-19 Auto Texts available for use within the ieMR:

- `covid19adm – Admission (full)
- `covid19assess - Assessment (insert)
- `covid19progwr – Progress ward round
- `covid19home – HITH COVID patients
- `covid19phone – Phone initial assessment

`covid19adm – Admission (full)

The `covid19adm admission auto text is intended for use upon admission of a confirmed COVID-19 patient, detailing the initial assessment of the patient and instructions for the ongoing management of the patient's care. Use of the auto text can occur for confirmed COVID-19 patients admitted to either the hospital as an acute inpatient or as a hospital in the home (HITH) patient.
