

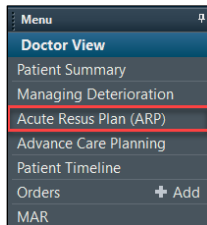
Creating a Paediatric Acute Resuscitation Plan (PARP)


Quick Reference Guide

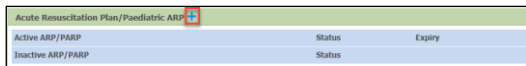
Clinicians will now have access to a new, custom tab in the ieMR called *Acute Resus Plan (ARP)*. The purpose of this page is to provide a single location to chart and review electronic ARPs.

Creating a new ARP/PARP

1. Launch ieMR. Within a patient record, use the *Menu* to navigate to *Acute Resus Plan (ARP)*.

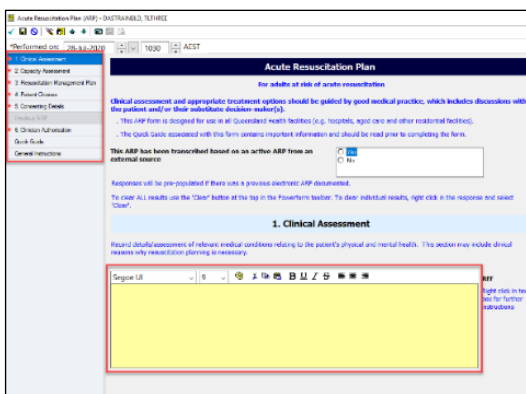


2. Click on  to add a new ARP/PARP form.

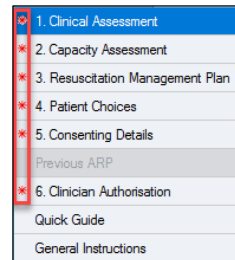



Note: The patient's date of birth will trigger the appropriate electronic form to launch (i.e. the Paediatric Acute Resuscitation Plan (PARP) will display if the patient is **under 18 years of age**).

3. Click through each section of the *Mini Menu* located at the top left of the form and complete all clinically appropriate fields.



Note: All yellow fields are mandatory and must be completed. A red asterisk (*) on the Mini Menu will indicate that a segment has incomplete mandatory field/s within it.



4. Once the form is complete, click the  in the top left corner to sign the form.

Note: Do not save the form. If saved, the ARP/PARP will not display, and it must be started again.

5. Click *Refresh* to view the PARP.

Utilising the Reference Text, Quick Guide and General Instructions

1. Within the ARP/PARP form, select *Quick Guide / General Instructions* from the *Mini menu* or click in a *yellow mandatory field*.
2. As per the instructions, right-click in the click box and select *Reference Text*.
3. A new window will open and display the *text*.
4. Click *OK* to close and return to the ARP/PARP form.

Note: Each segment will provide a **different** reference text relevant to that segment.
