Documenting Food Allergies

Quick reference guide

The correct recording of food allergies within the ieMR is important to ensure that the PFM and ieMR allergies are aligned.

Allergies that are already recorded should be marked as reviewed which ensures that the allergies will be transitioned to the dietary ordering system.

Adding Food Allergy

1. Enter category as "Food"

2. Change reaction type to "intolerance" or "sensitivity" as required.

3. Add comments as required

Marking Allergies as Reviewed

1. Clicking Mark as Reviewed will stamp the date and time into the reviewed column
