



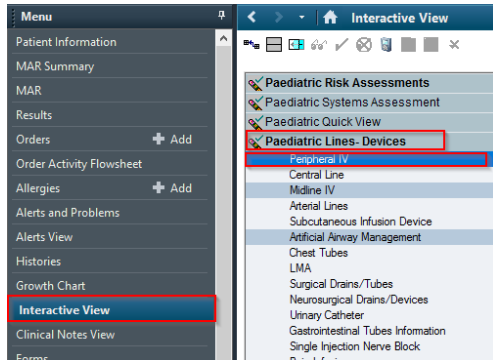

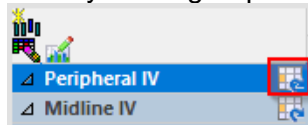
Quick reference guide

Creating a Line Dynamic Group

1. Select **Interactive View** and click the **Lines – Devices** navigator band



2. Click on the dynamic group icon to create a new dynamic group for the type of line

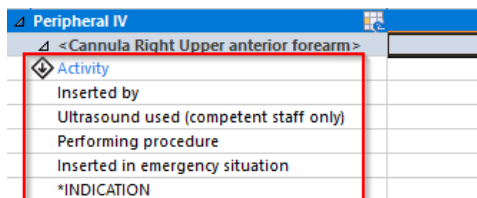


3. Document the corresponding properties in the dynamic group label and click **OK**

Note: If a patient has multiple lines, each line will need a separate Dynamic Group created

Documenting the Line Insertion

1. Complete all fields from **Activity** down to and including ***INDICATION** as clinically appropriate
2. Upon completion click **Sign** ✓



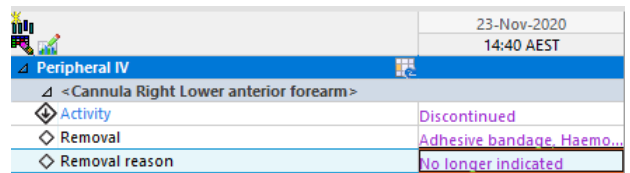
Note: It is vital that **Activity** is documented correctly for data collection – only complete the insertion activity **ONCE** for each line.

Note: If further information about a field is required, click on the [blue hyperlinks](#) to see reference texts.

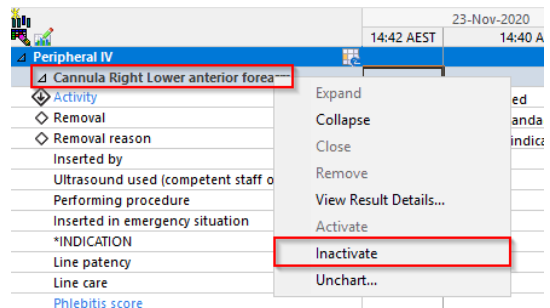
Removal documentation and inactivation of a Line

1. Locate the appropriate dynamic group
2. In the Activity field select **Discontinued**

Note: As the **Activity** field is a conditional field (◇), complete the removal and removal reason fields as clinically appropriate.



3. Upon completion click **Sign** ✓
4. Right click on the name of the dynamic group label and select **Inactivate**



Consider discontinuing relevant orders (e.g. **Line Care Peripheral IV Care, Subcutaneous Line Care, Central Venous Line Care, PICC Line Care, Midline Catheter Care**) if relevant line(s) have been removed, the corresponding checks are no longer required.

Note: When a patient is discharged with a line insitu, ensure to document the Activity as **Discharged with line insitu** and **Inactivate** the dynamic group
