Quick reference guide

Note: Once signed and finalised, data entered into a cell in *Interactive View (iView)* in the Patient Medical Record can be **modified** if it was entered incorrectly. Alternatively, **unchart** the data from the cell if it was entered in error.

Modifying data that was entered incorrectly

- Right click on the cell with the data you'd like to change and select **Modify**.
- Enter your new data.
- Click **sign**  to finalise, a **blue triangle**  will appear in that cell to indicate the data has been modified.

Uncharting allows you to remove data from a cell that was entered in error and is not relevant to that cell field.

To unchart data entered in error


- Right click on the cell with the data you want to remove and select **Unchart**. The **Unchart** window will appear.
- Select a **Reason** from the drop-down menu. A comment can be added in the **Comment** box too.

A black arrow  in the top right corner of the **uncharted cell** indicates a comment was made regarding it. To view it Right click and select **View Comments**.

Note: Modified data: To view the previously entered data, right click and select **View Result Details**.

Uncharted data: To view the previously entered data before it was uncharted, right click and select **View Result Details**.
