

## MAR summary: overview

### Quick reference guide

The **MAR Summary** is an overview of the Medication Administration Record (MAR).

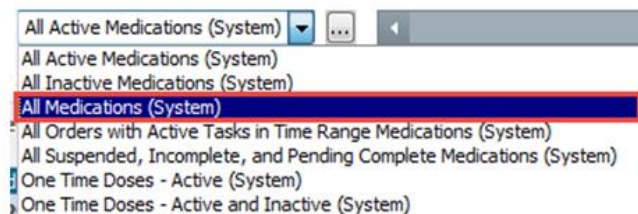
- The **MAR Summary** is display only, you cannot chart from this view.
- The **MAR Summary** displays cross encounter medication information.
- You can customise the time frame, time columns, sections and IV events according to your individual requirements.

1. Click on the **MAR Summary** in the menu.



### All Medications (System)

1. Change the filter to **All Medications (System)** by selecting it from the dropdown menu.

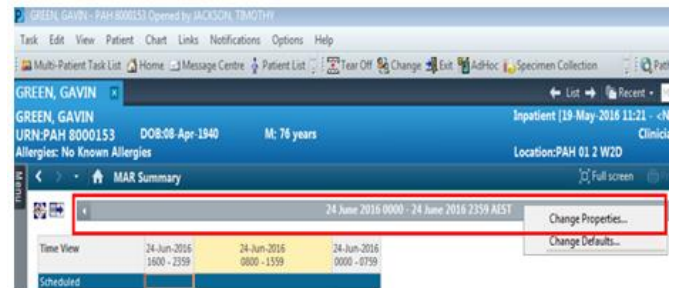


**Note:** In **All Active Medication (System)**, the stat/NOW/Once Only and discontinued medication orders will NOT be visible.

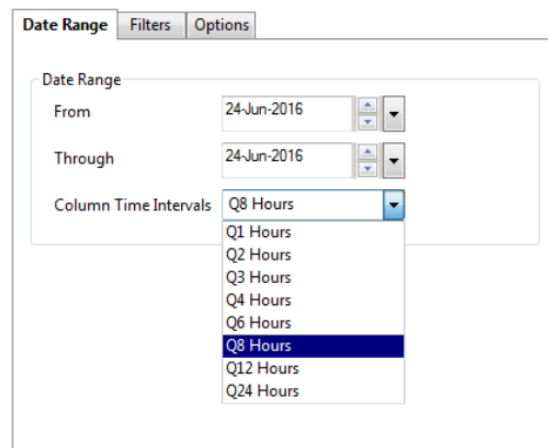
### Time Interval Settings

The default view is 8 hours per column.

1. To modify the time interval setting (or the date range), right click the **Grey Information Bar** and select **Change Properties**.



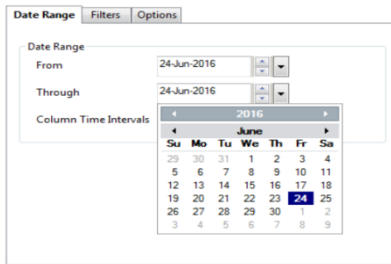
2. Click on the **Column Time Intervals** dropdown to select from **Q1 Hours** up to **Q24 Hours**.



### Date Range

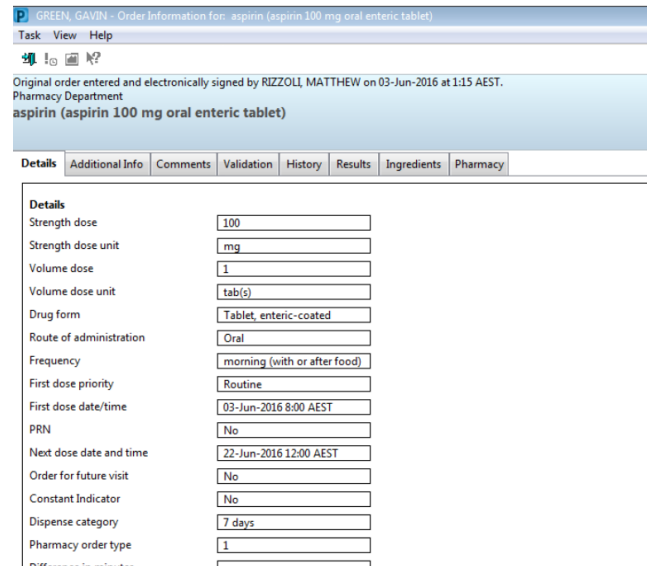
1. To modify the date range, click the **From** and **Through** dropdown menus as required.  
By clicking the large dropdown down arrow, the calendar function launches.



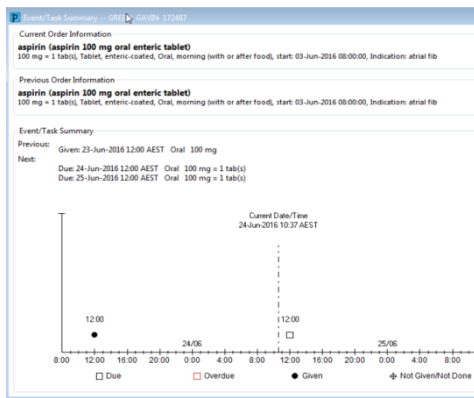


### View Event/Task Summary and Order Info

- By hovering over the **order sentence** the below medication pop up box will appear.



- Click on the **Event/Task Summary** for an overview of the dose information.



Click on **Order Info** to view further medication information and tabs such as **Details**, **Additional Info**, **Comments**, **Validation**, **History**, **Results**, **Ingredients**, **Pharmacy**.

### MAR Summary Medication Status

Depending on their status, medications on the **MAR Summary** will display differently.

- Charted medications are displayed with the given dose and the time it was administered. (1)
- Not Given** or **Not Done** administrations are displayed with an orange border with the reason and charting time. (2)
- Overdue meds are displayed with a red background and overdue icon. (3)
- Discontinued meds are displayed with a dark grey background for that row. (4)
- Immediate priority tasks are displayed with a red background and the text **STAT** or **NOW**. (5)
- Cells that only have a time (e.g. @1900) display administration tasks that have not yet been documented against. (6)
