



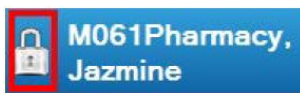

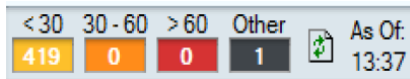
Quick reference guide

The Lock Icon shown below means that other users cannot add or edit medication orders in PowerChart for the selected patient, while the patient's Acute Profile is open in PharmNet.



Unverified Orders Monitor (UVOM)

Shown below. Also known as the Mini Monitor.



UVOM sections explained.

The number of orders waiting for verification by a Pharmacist; where a dose is due to be administered within the next 30 minutes. Orders which have already had the first dose administered to a patient also fall into this category.

Other PharmNet Icons



This icon will display if the order contains Order Comments.



An Intervention Icon will display if a Pharmacist has documented an intervention against a medication order.



PowerPlan Icon, which is a group of one or more orders that may include: medications, pathology requests, radiology, investigations, patient care and assessments.



Unassigned Product Icon indicates that a medication has not been automatically product assigned. Product assignment will need to be performed manually by a Pharmacist.



Home Medication Icon, it appears if patient's is using their own meds.

Order requires Pharmacist verification Icon.



Pharmacist Rejected Order Icon.



Discern Icon indicates the clinical decision support was overridden.



Link Icon indicates the ordered medication is to be ordered in conjunction with another order in a



PowerPlan.
