

## Print a Paediatric Acute Resuscitation Plan (PARP)


### Quick Reference Guide


Clinicians will now have access to a new, custom tab in the ieMR called *Acute Resus Plan (ARP)*. The purpose of this page is to provide a single location to chart and review electronic ARPs.

**Note:** Only *active* PARP/ARPs should be printed.

### Print an active ARP/PARP

To print an active ARP/PARP on discharge/transfer or for the parent/ guardian.

1. Launch ieMR.
2. Select  **Medical Record Request** from the toolbar.
3. Under *Template*, select R4 Transfer Report.
4. Under *Purpose*, select the reason for printing the ARP/PARP.
5. Enter the *Date Range* (note the date the active ARP/PARP was created).
6. Click *Sections*.
7. Scroll down to find *ARP Form RTF* and *check the box*.
8. Click *Preview*.
9. Click *Yes*, to preview the pdf.
10. Print as per usual process, using a colour printer if available.
