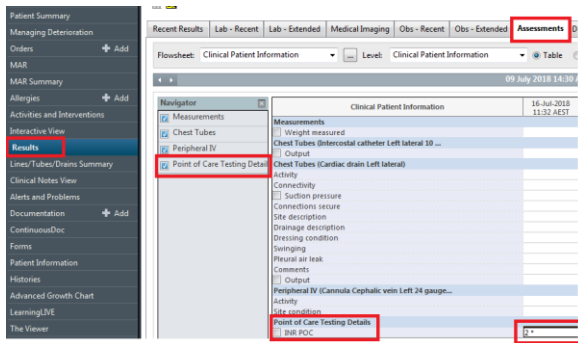

Review documented INR

1. Navigate to *Results* → *Assessments* → *Point of Care Testing Information*

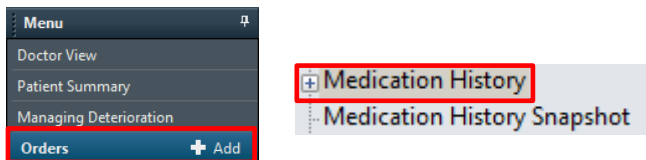


2. Locate the *INR POC* data field
3. Right click on the result and select *View Comments* to view additional information documented by nursing staff, including: current warfarin dose, issues/concerns and parent/carer contact phone number

Reviewing previous doses

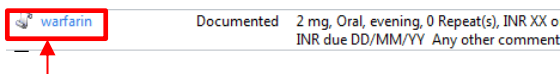
To view previous order information/dosing:

1. Navigate to *Orders* and select *Medication History* to view scripts and home medications

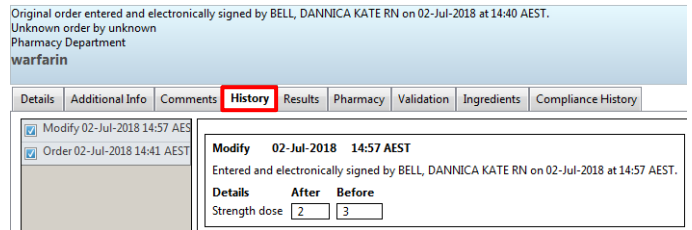


2. Click on the **blue text** of the *warfarin home medication* – evident by the scroll icon

warfarin to view *Order Information*



3. From *Order Information*, select the *History* tab to view previous doses

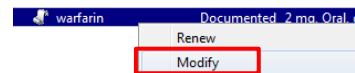


4. Exit to return to the orders page

Note: You can also use the *Medication History Snapshot* to view changes to home medications and prescriptions over time, by highlighting all warfarin orders once one is selected.

Update/Modify current dose

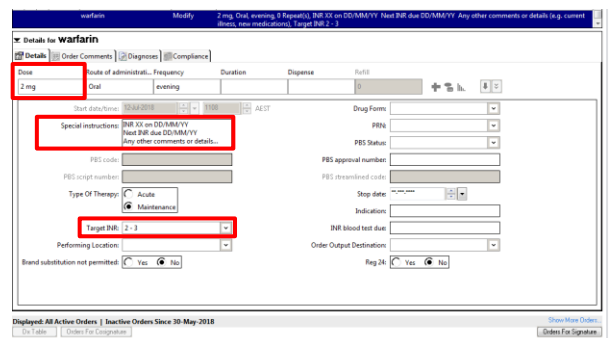
1. Within the *Orders* page, right click on the documented warfarin home medication and select *Modify*



2. Document today's dose and in the *special instructions* state:

- a. The current INR and date
- b. Date of next INR
- c. Any other comments or details (eg current illness, new medications)

3. Document the *Target INR*




4. Select *Orders for Signature* and *Sign*


Complete Scripts



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If there are any prescriptions with previous doses specified, it is important to “complete” these scripts when adjusting home dosing.

1. Locate the warfarin script – evident by the pill bottle icon  warfarin (Marevan 1 mg oral tablet)
2. Right click and select *Complete*
