Chart not given Medication Management Quick reference guide

To chart medication tasks as **Not Given** using the **MAR** follow the steps below:

Note: A **Not Given** medication refers to a medication that:

1. Is withheld or unable to be given as per nursing clinical judgement.
or
2. A refused medication (see possible reasons in point 4).

Note: A medication withheld by the doctor as a phone/verbal order (not ordered as a withhold in the **MAR**) will need to be documented as a Chart Not Done.

1. Navigate to the **MAR** from the **Menu**.
2. Click the scheduled administration task you need to chart as not given.

The **Medication Administration** window will open.

3. Select the checkbox **Not Given**.
4. Select your reason from the dropdown menu.

5. Add a **comment**.
6. Click the green to Sign.
7. Refresh the page.

The result will now display as **Not Given** with the selected reason.
