Routine INR / Clexane Dosing Management

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Please call **Monday to Friday between 8am to 2pm** only

Leave a voice message or text (phone will not be answered) advising that your child has had an INR or clexane level.

Please make sure that your message or text includes the following information:

- Your child's name, date of birth and/or medical record number (if known)
- A return contact number for the haematology team to call or text to discuss dosing
- Where the INR / clexane level was collected (e.g which hospital, QML, Sullivan Nicolaides, Mater Pathology etc)
- Your child's INR reading if done on a home testing machine
- Your child's current warfarin / clexane dose and how long they have been on this dose
- If there has been any illness or medication / dietary changes

The Haematology team will contact you by 4pm with a dosing plan and when to recheck your child's INR / clexane level

- NOTE: This phone **will not** be checked after 4pm Monday to Friday or on weekends or public holidays.

Emergency Action Plan

- You will have been given specific information related to possible serious side effects of your child's anticoagulation. **These signs usually relate to unusual or prolonged bleeding, or very high INR / clexane results.** Please contact the Haematology team, using the numbers below, for advice or present to your nearest hospital emergency department. If your child is very unwell or seriously injured call for an ambulance on 000.
