## HAND WASHING

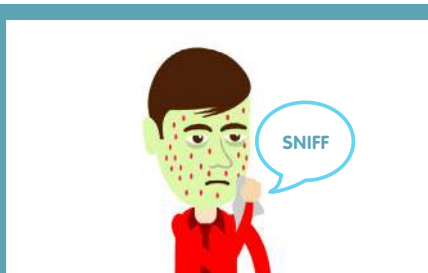


Super heroes have very clean hands. But invisible germs hide in all sorts of places.



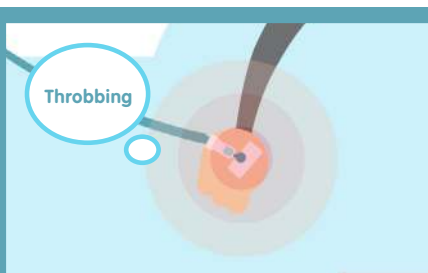
Super heroes wash their hands, ask other people to and thank them when they do.

## UNWELL VISITORS



Sometimes visitors might be sick too and have their own germs. If your visitors feel unwell they should stay at home until they're better.

## ITCHY TUBES



When super heroes are hurting they tell someone. Sometimes they need medicines that run through plastic tubes. If these tubes itch or hurt, super heroes tell someone.

## WRISTBAND DETAILS



To get better, super heroes need lots of medicine.  
Make sure YOUR wristband has YOUR details on it, just like Maya's.

## FEELING WORSE



Sometimes super heroes start to feel worse even though they're in hospital.



If this happens to you, ask for help straight away.

## PRESSURE ULCERS



Pressure ulcers can be a nasty problem. Super heroes fight them by moving about and using special equipment.
